Landscaping – Alders cleanup

You will notice that there is a lot of changes to the landscape around the church. As we were removing the alders, we became aware of a severe water buildup below the church and the parish house; a problem that we had to fix. Drain pipes are being installed to move water away from the house and church. Once completed the landscape will be graded to look beautiful.

Sale of Parish Hall – Restoration Projects

We are still waiting for the survey of the property so that we can put the property and hall up for sale. When the sale is completed and we know how much money we will have, we are hoping to begin some major restorations to the church. These projects include: Roof shingles replacement, upgrade to the electrical system, heat pumps installation, carpet replacement, renovations to the entrance of the church to create a gathering space and office. We estimate that these projects will cost \$120,000 - \$130,000

Summer Schedule - Parish Priests

Sometime this summer, hopefully we will begin renovations to the church, both interior and exterior, once we get approval from the engineers of the Town. During these renovations the church will be closed for all celebrations until all projects are completed. We thank Fr Brian Colbert and Fr David Joy for celebrating Mass with us. Fr Brophy is recovering at his family's home in St. John's.
