

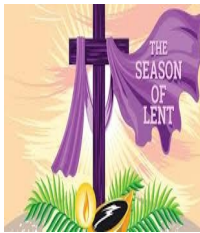

**MARCH 26 - FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT:**

Today we hear the account of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead, a miraculous event which is placed immediately before Jesus' passion and death in Saint John's

Gospel. The raising of Lazarus is the final sign which led the Jerusalem authorities to decide to put Christ to death. Jesus, bringing life, is put to death and is placed in a tomb. Ultimately, however, he triumphs and rises to new life. Dying and rising from the dead, Jesus brings hope of eternal life to all who, like Lazarus, must die. This hope is realized in the Sacrament of Baptism and is the great Mystery of Faith proclaimed at every Mass. With a greater sense of awareness, let us joyfully proclaim this great Mystery of Faith each time we celebrate Mass: *"We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again."*
