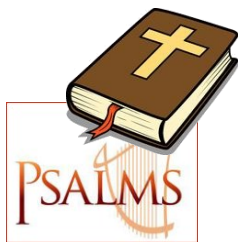

Saint Monica and Her Son (Fr Brophy)

Monica was born in the year 333 in North Africa. She had three children, one of which was Augustine. As Monica was a Christian lady, a woman of deep faith, she grieved over Augustine wayward lifestyle as he had a lady lover with whom he had a son.

But Monica recognized that Augustine was brilliant, and capable of great things. She prayed and prayed and fasted and encouraged Augustine at every opportunity. In an effort to distance himself from his mother, Augustine sailed to Rome. Monica followed him. A kind bishop, a friend of Monica said: "It is not possible that a son of so many tears should be lost." Secretly, Augustine sailed to Milan. Monica followed. While in Milan, Augustine heard of a very wise bishop named Ambrose whose sermons were drawing large crowds. Secretly, Augustine went to hear Ambrose and was won over to the Christian faith. He was baptized and led a exemplary life from then onward. He became a priest. Augustine's writings are the most profound, the greatest writings from the early centuries of the Church.
