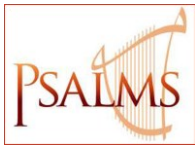

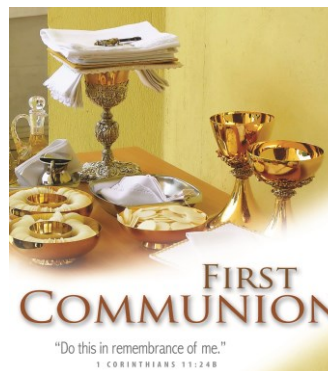

### Saint Kateri - Lily of the Mohawks

*(Monday April 17, 2023)*

In 2012, Kateri was canonized a saint. Kateri is the first North American indigenous woman to be canonized. When she was four years old, a smallpox epidemic killed her parents and left her with seriously impaired eyesight and a disfigured face. Kateri was baptized on Easter Sunday 1676. She had a strong devotion to the Eucharist and a deep concern for others. Saint Kateri is the patron saint of World Youth Day, those who have lost their parents and ecology.
