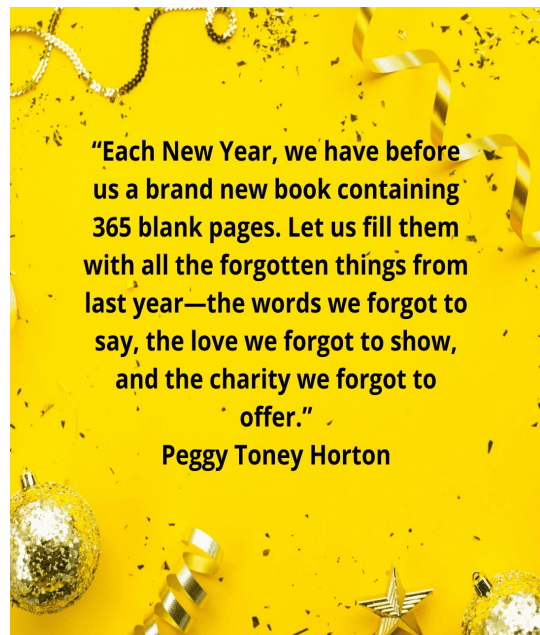
Thursday Night card games will resume on Thursday, January 12, 2023 in the Town Hall Basement. Come and bring a friend!
