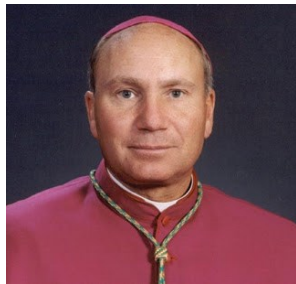
Easter Message From Father Brophy

When we understand this, the grief of Peter, the grief of Mary the mother of Jesus, and the grief of the women who accompanied Jesus becomes even more overwhelming.
