Come join us as we explore ways to pray with God's Holy Word.

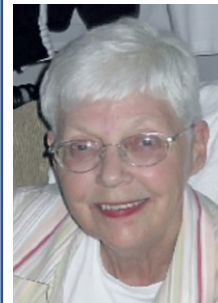
