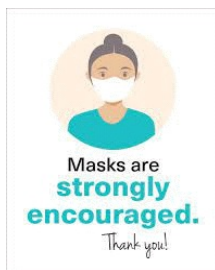

AUGUST 28 - TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:

Today's Gospel is a lesson in humility. As we hear Jesus tell the

Moreover, we are to allow them to take the seats of honour. Is this what we do at our Eucharistic gatherings? How welcoming are we to those who are different in status or wealth? Do we allow others to be fully "at home" in the company of the Lord Jesus? Only by acting in humility and in a spirit of true generosity can we hope to be honoured at the "resurrection of the righteous".
