Saint Cyprian on the Lord's Prayer (Fr. Brophy)

Above all, Jesus, who preaches peace and unity, did not want us to pray by ourselves in private or for ourselves alone. We do not say "My Father, who art in heaven", or "Give me this day my daily bread". It is not for himself alone that each person asks to be forgiven, or not to be led into temptation, or to be delivered from evil. Rather, we pray in public as a community, and not for one individual, but for all. For the people of God are all one. God is the teacher of harmony, peace and unity, and he desires that we pray for all, just as Jesus died for all, so that all may be saved.

Memorial Day *(Fr. Brophy)*

This Day, July 1st, has a much more solemn reason for families in Newfoundland to remember and to grieve. During World War I, on July 1st, the Newfoundland Regiment called the Blue Puttees, suffered enormous losses. In the battle of Beaumont Hamel, eight hundred Newfoundland soldiers engaged the enemy. On that day, seven hundred of our soldiers were either killed or wounded. On the following day, only sixty eight Newfoundland soldiers were able to answer the roll call. There was hardly a community in Newfoundland that was not left in sorrow following the huge losses on July 1st, 1916.
