JANUARY 14 - SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:

In today's Gospel, we are presented with another epiphany when John the Baptist, who is standing with two of his disciples, refers to Jesus as the "Lamb of God", thus identifying Christ's ultimate purpose in life which is to redeem sinful humanity. We hear this familiar title in our prayers during Mass and we know and believe that Jesus, the sacrificial Lamb of God, died that we might be free of our sins. By calling Jesus the "Lamb of God", John actually points the two disciples away from himself and towards Jesus. This is what we too, as disciples of the Lord Jesus, are called to do. By virtue of our baptism, we too are called to point the way to Jesus, to make him known to all the world by our words and by the witness of our lives. It is a call to give without counting the cost, to pour out one's life for the sake

of the Gospel in imitation of Jesus, the "Lamb of God", who gave his life for the salvation of humanity.
